On March 25, 2005, Customs and Border Protection (CBP) announced mandatory security requirements for C-TPAT importers. Any and all new importers joining C-TPAT must meet this minimum security criteria prior to joining. For those C-TPAT members who are certified, CBP has established deadlines for the criteria to be met – beginning with the first deadline of May 23, 2005.
